

**BELLEROSE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

**RESOLUTION # 2018-12-17-02**

**WHEREAS**, a system of fire alarm call boxes was installed in the Village several decades ago to provide a means of summoning fire-fighters, even before the general availability of telephones; and

**WHEREAS**, these fire alarm call boxes have become antiquated and no longer function as a reliable or efficient means of alerting the Village Fire Department to an instance of fire or other emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the existence of fire alarm call boxes along public by-ways may be misinterpreted as a reliable means of emergency notification, especially because such boxes have either been disconnected or are malfunctioning,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that all remaining fire alarm call boxes existing along public roads be retired and that notification thereof be duly posted and announced in the Village Website. Further that, at least one (1) such fire alarm call box shall remain part of the Village inventory of historic materials, and duly displayed as may be deemed appropriate in a public place, as a reflection of a by-gone system and element of life which played an important role in local history. The remaining fire alarm call boxes shall be placed in the care of the Bellerose Village Fire Department for disposal as the Board of Trustees may deem fit.
