PARKING DURING ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Residents with homes on Ontario Road between the Dead End and Commonwealth Blvd. and on Hudson Road between Massachusetts Blvd. and Commonwealth Blvd. have been issued special parking placards to place in their car windshields to permit them to park on designated village streets while their roads are closed for the road construction project.

The Village has a record of all vehicles and license plate numbers for the residents with the placards. These residents must display the placards in their car windows and park only in the designated locations throughout the Village for the safety and access of all. Vehicles not displaying a parking placard or parked outside of the designated locations may be subject to a summons or towing. All other Bellerose Village parking regulations are still in effect.

No parking is allowed on Massachusetts, Commonwealth and Pennsylvania Blvds. during the road project to allow for through traffic and road crew operations. We ask for your cooperation and consideration for neighbors displaying parking placards whose cars may be parked in front of your home during the road construction project.

Parking during road construction is scheduled from October 25, 2019 through November 27, 2019. These dates may be subject to change. Nassau County Police will assist us in enforcing these special parking rules and ensuring the safety and security of the Village.
