

**INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF BELLEROSE**

**LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER (CORONAVIRUS) 1-2020**

Dated: April 22, 2020

I, KENNETH MOORE, as the Mayor of the Inc. Village of Bellerose, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Code of the Village of Bellerose and §24 of the New York State Executive Law,

THAT, in order to preserve the public safety and property of the Village residents,

DOES HEREBY ORDER:

The Village is declared under a STATE of EMERGENCY; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

A. Effective April 2, 2020, Village Hall and all facilities are closed to the public; and the public may email [Villageclerk@bellerosevillage.org](mailto:Villageclerk@bellerosevillage.org) and call 516.354.1000 to address any Village business filings; and

B. Any meetings of the official Boards or committees of the Village, with exception of the Board of Trustees, are hereby adjourned and reschedule until after May 17, 2020 or after; and

C. The Board of Trustees meeting scheduled for April 27, 2020 shall proceed with participation to be arranged remotely pursuant to the Public Officer's Law. It is encouraged that the public submit any comments or questions via email to the Village Clerk; and

D. All Parks and Recreation Department events are cancelled and subject to rescheduling after May 17 2020; and

E. The Village reminds all that the Governor of the State of New York mandated effective March 16, 2020 at 8:00 p.m., that all bars, restaurants, cafes, and larger venues will be CLOSED and will implement take-out and/or delivery only of their products; and

F. The Village continues to work with its government partners and/or public health advisors to immediately implement further recommended public health prevention guidance;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

G. That given the advice of Public Health experts, access to outdoor playground equipment is prohibited; and

H. The Board of Trustees Reorganizational Meeting schedules for April 6, 2020 is adjourned until June 1, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED:

I. That all conditions and directives contained in New York State Local Emergency Orders are renewed, continued and extended in full force and effect; and

J. The timeframe under Real Property Tax Law §718, and related procedural requirements relating to the challenge of Village assessments, are hereby extended for the 2020/2021 tax year under 45 days from the recommencement of electronic filing availability by the Nassau County Clerk; and

K. The filing of 2020/21 tax year petitions are hereby extended until further notice and, when filing is recommenced by the Nassau County Clerk, the Village waives the personal service requirement and agrees to electronic filing via the designated Village email for service, and will not require individual copies of petitions for cases otherwise listed in a maser petition.

Except as stated above, this Order shall be effective IMMEDIATELY and shall remain in effect until removed by further order of the Mayor.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law §24(5).
