

2022 E-Cycle & Shredding Schedule

By disposing of older computer and electronic products at an E-cycle event, you can prevent toxins from entering the waste stream and comply with New York State law requiring consumers to recycle electronic waste. Please visit hempsteadny.gov/225/e-cycling for more information about electronic recycling. Residents may also bring their personal papers and confidential documents to be shredded, free of charge (limit of 5 file boxes or 5 paper bags).

Materials to be shredded should be brought in paper bags or cardboard boxes (no plastic bags please). Witnessed shredding is available on a first-come, first-served basis. When shredding trucks reach maximum capacity, shredding must take place off-site. Cell phones are not accepted at E-cycling events.

E-waste, S.T.O.P. items and shredding materials will not be accepted from commercial establishments, schools, churches, synagogues or home businesses. No commercial vehicles permitted at these events.
